FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

Indoor Jaguar Holding : The metal panel on the shift door wall is rusting along the bottom edge of the wall. These areas weaken the strength of the wall and need to be repaired or replaced to maintain structural strength.

The wooden surface of the sleeping platform is splintering in several areas due to chewing and clawing. These areas need to be repaired or replaced to prevent injury to the jaguar .
