(e) Public barriers. Fixed public exhibits housing nonhuman primates, such as zoos, must have a barrier between the primary enclosure and the public at any time the public is present, in order to restrict physical contact between the public and the nonhuman primates.

Goldheaded Tamarin Exhibit : There is a barrier fence present and in most areas is at least 36 " from the primary enclosure fence. In one area it is only 29 " from the primary enclosure and in another it measures 31 " from the enclosure. At these distances, it is easier to reach across the barrier and contact the enclosure fence. The public barriers surrounding this and all other exhibits must be repaired to ensure that they restrict physical contact between the public and non human primates. CORRECT BY : 7-1-2011
