HANDLING OF ANIMALS.

(b)(1) Handling of all animals shall be done as expeditiously and carefully as possible in a manner that does not cause trauma, overheating, excessive cooling, behavioral stress, physical harm, or unnecessary discomfort.

** On December 18th, 2011, this licensee was transporting an adult reindeer for exhibition when the back door of the trailer used for transport opened and the reindeer fell out onto the highway while the trailer was moving. The licensee stated that the trailer door was not locked or pinned before transport. The licensee also stated that the reindeer was returned to the facility without performing the exhibition and that the attending veterinarian examined the animal the same day and 3 days after this incident. This lack of care to ensure the door was secured resulted in this incident and injury to the reindeer. The licensee must ensure that handling of all animals is done carefully to ensure the safety and well-being of the animals. Correct this by properly handling all animals.

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION REQUIRED

Note: The reindeer was returned to the facility from where it was leased.
