FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

--On Feb-27-2013 the 5 month old male jaguar "Fitzgerald" was found to be limping and had a wound on it's left front paw. The staff suspects the jaguar put its paw where the adult jaguar could cause injury to its paw. The facility has since put smaller mesh wire inside the young jaguar's area to minimize interaction between the young animal and the adult.

The facility must be constructed to protect the animals from injury.

This was a focused inspection concentrating on a juvenile jaguar, an adult female lion, and a young giraffe.
